## Tuesday September 14, 2010 Beehive Natural Area

### An Interpretive Hike

In the headwaters of the Oldman river in southwestern Alberta, this protected area is a stunning mix of cool, dark sub-alpine forests and broad, green alpine meadows. These vistas are highlighted by the looming summits of neighbouring mountain peaks. The Beehive Natural Area provides habitat for grizzlies and summer range for elk and bighorn sheep. Golden eagles may also be seen soaring over their domain.

Please Note: This hike is rated as Moderate-to-Difficult, extending approximately 10 kilometres with an elevation gain of about 400 metres (1300 feet).
