Experience fall colours and vistas in this classic montane landscape, one of the largest remaining examples of this fascinating ecosystem. We will wander the trails, ridges and valleys and visit ancient pines clinging precariously to the slopes. The Whaleback is home to wildlife such as deer, elk, bears, coyotes and wolves. A popular hike, so plan to register early!

This hike is rated as Moderate-to-Difficult, covering approximately 12 - 14 kilometres with an elevation gain of about 300 metres (1000 ft).
