



Live Streaming of Grassy Mtn Hearings Starts Tomorrow



Finally... the Joint Review Panel Hearings into Benga Mining's plan to decapitate Grassy Mountain are about to start.

During the past several days there have been a handful of news stories that have featured the opposition of AWA and others to Benga's ambitions. Our opposition has appeared in stories appearing in [The Globe and Mail](#) and the [Calgary Herald](#).

Today, the Impact Assessment Agency published its revised schedule for this

first week of the hearings.
