Before the hearing began, I speculated that this dimension of Benga Mining's proposal to exploit metallurgical coal would be the company's strongest suit. Given the range of serious environmental questions that will be raised in the hearing, I thought Benga had to make a strong case for the positive socio-economic effects of its project. But, a strong case only can be built on a solid foundation of favourable markets for coking coal. This post argues that this foundation is weak.
