AWA Hike: Spring Sandhills and Horse Lake

Friday June 8, 2018

After hiking through a partially cleared forest, the "Sandhills" are reached. They are a unique feature in the foothills ridges with some areas covered by only bare sand. Further beyond are extensive wetlands and a small lake in an area frequented by wild horses.

AWA Hike: Porcupine Hills

Thursday June 28, 2018

Situated between the mountains and the prairies and located east of Claresholm, the Porcupine Hills are a unique area. The area gets its name from the ancient Douglas-fir and limber pine trees that populate the crests of the hills.

AWA Hike: Wainwright Dunes

Thursday July 5, 2018

The Wainwright Dunes Ecological Reserve is part of a large and diverse area of sandy glacial deposits. Located 33 km southeast of Wainwright, AB this reserve is famous for its sand dunes that can reach heights of 30 meters. Hikers will be walking through mature balsam poplar, stunted aspen groves, shrub-grasslands and shrubby fen wetlands.
