The above photo was taken exactly 32 years ago today. On June 11 1989 this concert held near the site of the Oldman Dam in southern Alberta featured Ian Tyson and many other great musicians, attracting throngs of people from all over the province. On such an important anniversary for AWA, we wanted to tell you the story of that concert, and invite you to take part in another one!

Opposed to the Oldman Dam, in 1989 people came and listened and sent a message of protest. This message made it all the way to the Supreme Court of Canada and won important changes to environmental assessment legislation in this country.

This story of protest and the voices of people willing to stand up and be heard - is a story we have repeated many times in 2020 - 2021.

We have stood up to protest changes being made to our Eastern Slopes; coal

mining in some of our most pristine valleys and wildlife corridors; changes to guiding policies that we depended on for protection of these natural and welcoming landscapes. We have protested, written letters, spoken out and answered surveys.
