## Cliff Wallis appointed to the Order of Canada

Her Excellency the Right Honourable Mary Simon, Governor General of Canada, announced 85 new appointments to the Order of Canada, including Alberta Wilderness Association board member Clifford Wallis, who is also FSC Canada's chair of the board of directors.

The Order of Canada is one of our country's highest honours. Since its creation in 1967, the Order of Canada has recognized people across all sectors of society who have made extraordinary and sustained contributions to our nation.

Cliff Wallis was given this award for his dedication to advancing nature conservation and restoration in Alberta, as an esteemed biologist and naturalist.
