

Six companies hold active coal leases throughout the Livingstone Range and within the Oldman headwaters, which ultimately drains into the South Saskatchewan River Basin. Many of the tributaries of the Oldman are designated as critical habitat for species at risk, including threatened bull trout and Westslope cutthroat trout populations. Numerous parks, protected areas, and recreation sites can also be found throughout the region. Downstream communities include Medicine Hat, Lethbridge, Pincher Creek, and the Kainai and Piikani Nations.
